For the past 18 years we have been partnering with them as they have evangelized and discipled the people of that region. Their stories and testimonies read like an extension of the book of Acts. Churches have been planted, Christian schools have been established, radio programs and Bible book stores have been opened and the fellowship of the saints has been encouraged by the steadfast work of the Mattis. They have truly dreamed seemingly impossible dreams and then have seen them come true by the hand of God.
