

I. Cell Leadership Structure

- ◆ **Interns** – Assist the Cell Leader
- ◆ **Cell Leaders** – Pastor members/Facilitate the cell meeting
- ◆ **Zone Pastors** – Coach 2 - 4 Cell Leaders
- ◆ **Area Pastors** – Mentor/Develop 2 - 4 Zone Pastors
- ◆ **District Pastors** – Lead/Resource 4 - 9 Area Pastors
- ◆ **Cell Life Pastor** – Manage/improve the Cell system
- ◆ **Senior Pastor** – Leads the church

II. Cell Meeting Format – The Basic Skeleton – The 4W's

- ◆ **Welcome** – Greeting and Ice Breaker, introductions (5-15)
- ◆ **Worship** – Worship, sing, experience the presence of God, then pray for and minister to one another as there is need (20-40)
- ◆ **Word** – Reflect on the sermon, and apply a SPECK of truth, using ABCs (20-40)
- ◆ **Works** – Corporate prayer and intercession, plan outreaches and special cell events, attend to cell business (5-15)
- ◆ **Why 4W's?**
 - Assures an initial, basic level of nurturing and pasturing is taking place, built on Belmont's values (CODE)
 - The 'menu' is essentially the same but the 'portions' may vary week to week. Think balance!
 - Promotes predictability, and continuity.
 - Affords a safe environment so relationships can develop over time.
 - Provides varying opportunities for different gifts to be exercised.
 - Creates a safe place to 'practice' for the marketplace
- ◆ **TIPS for Using the 4W's**
 - Let them guide you and build predictability to your meeting
 - Use them as the basic 'track' you run on week to week
 - BRIEFLY envision the next portion before beginning
 - Vary the WAY you do the 4Ws – use creativity!
 - Assign portions of the 4Ws to your Intern or other members
 - Use all 4 'portions', but vary the 'quantity' of each week to week
 - Let the 4Ws serve you – you don't serve the 4Ws

III. Cell Leaders

- ◆ **Qualifications**
 - Capable – Love God and are trustworthy (Exodus 18:21)
 - Chosen – Asked/recommended by Cell Leader (Acts 3:3)
 - Fast – Faithful, Available, Submissive, Teachable
- ◆ **Characteristics**
 - Primary Role: Pastor members/Facilitate meeting
 - Primary Image: Shepherd with a small flock of sheep
 - Primary Focus: Cell members, their walk with Jesus and seeing them mature in ministry
 - Primary Tasks: Seven "Ps" of Fruitfulness

- ◆ **Seven 'Ps' to Fruitfulness – Doing the Right Things Yields Right Results**
 - PRAY for your cell members
 - PHONE your Zone Pastor weekly, calling referrals to cell, and facilitate a weekly “touch-base” call for cell members
 - PLAN for your weekly cell meeting and for the next outreach or special event
 - PROCESS the 4Ws in the cell meeting, cell business (calling the Cell Hotline, filing the weekly Cell Report.
 - PURSUE relationships with your cell member outside of cell
 - PLAY and have times of celebration in cell
 - PERSEVERE in “doing” the basics, expecting the Lord to bless the work of your hands
- ◆ **Bearing/Sharing the Ministry: Training a Cell Intern(s)**
 - Ask a Intern to help file weekly Cell Report
 - Facilitate calling cell members during the week
 - Lead the cell in the Cell Leaders absence
 - Assist the Cell Leader in planning for outreaches or special events
 - The more, the merrier, especially as multiplication time draws near

IV. Cell Leader/Cell Summary

- ◆ **G**uide the cell by example
- ◆ **C**o-orchestrate the cell through member gifts

- ◆ **F**our Ws
- ◆ **O**utreach
- ◆ **R**eproduction
- ◆ **W**alking under authority
- ◆ **A**lways open to anyone
- ◆ **R**elationships that transcend cell meetings
- ◆ **D**etermined to make it enjoyable
